
When history married Nature Wonders

- Day 10 Goa Gajah Temple, Tegalalang rice fields, Luwak coffee plantation, world's rarest coffee extracted from chive (wildcat) excrements, and panoramic view of Lake Batur before heading back to Ubud + bird watching as thousands of herons go nest at sunset
- Day 11 Transfert to Padang Bai. See the charming little city before trying tasteful local fruit juice cocktails.

- Day 13, 14 & 15 Gili Air: snorkeling + scuba diving (beginners & advanced) to witness an unmatched submarine eco-system. Dining on the beach every night: fresh fish of the day ir a heavenly atmosphere
