- Day 0/1** - Arrival at Keflavik airport + night in Reykjavik. Visit of Reykjavik, the old town and Hallgrímskirkja church
- Day 2** - Road to Snaefellsnessysla peninsula : Bjarnarhöfn landforms looking like frozen cakes, lavish Kirkjufellsfoss waterfall, and much more...
- Day 3/4** - North-Western Fjords, thousands of waterfalls, snowy mountains diving into the sea, et des natural hot springs to relax between hot and cold
- Day 5** - Road to Akureyri, Iceland's 2nd biggest city.
Optional 3h boat trip to see whales swimming. Laufas; small village with turf houses.
- Day 6/7** - Myvatn area : pure diversity. Mini craters, lava fields still smoking (Krafla), Mars like landscapes (Námafjall), boiling mud pits & sulfur fumes (Hverir), green fields, volcano (Hverfjall), lake in a crater (Viti), the list goes on and ends in Dettifoss, Europe's largest waterfall.
Note : for the sporty ones we offer the possibility to climb Vindbelgjarfjall and its impregnable view on the Myvatn area
- Day 8** - Road to Höfn through the Eastern Fjords.
- Day 9** - Jökulsárlón, iceberg lake. Svartifoss, black waterfall. Vik i Myrdal, volcanic black sand beach. Skogafoss & Seljalandsfoss, gem waterfalls + a surprise in an unknown location.
- Day 10-11** - Iceland's most tormented landscapes in Landmannalaugar, (open from mid June til mid September)
- Day 12** - Golden Circle + Blue Lagoon
Note : There is no night time in June, so we advise to bring blindfolds if you travel at this period of the year.

Is there anyone out there who never dreamed to step on Iceland's gorgeous wrath? The island of a 1000 faces transports all who ventured there thanks to its out-of-this-world settings and landscapes. The saying "You have to see it to believe it" couldn't be any truer.
